COURSE OBJECTIVES

In this workshop session participants will be asked to give feedback regarding the challenges in their working environment. The lessons learned will be discussed in a workshop format with the help of a facilitator.

Session 3 - ANNALYZING THE DIFFERENT TECHNIQUES

In this part of the program experts will analyse best practises namely:identification techniques, apprehending of suspects, identification and protection of evidence, investigation processes, effective prosecution processes.

Session 4 – TEAM EXERCISE Part 1

For this session the participants will be divided into teams that will work together to achieve results. The focus of this session will be on the different techniques to combat infrastructure theft in Utilities. The different teams will then be given scenarios to address.

Session 5 – TEAM EXERCISE Part 2

In this session delegates will be required to give feedback from Team exercise 4 and will in the process learn how to do project assessments, determine cost effectiveness and compile counter proposals

Session 5 - MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

Mentorship sessions will be conducted with each participant after the conclusion of the first two day training session, in order to monitor goals reached or challenges encountered.
